CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS Pursuant to requirements of the Georgia Con-stitution, Attorney General Christopher Carr, Secretary of State Brad Raffensperger, and Secretary of State Brad harrensperger, and Legislative Counsel Betsy Howerton hereby provide the summaries of the proposed con-stitutional amendments that will appear on the November 5, 2024, general election ballot for consideration by the people of Georgia (short captions are those adopted by the Constitu-tional Amendments Publication Board):

Provides for a general law state-wide home-stead exemption that may differentiate among political subdivisions. House Resolution No. 1022

Ga. L. 2024, p. 1191 "() YES () NO

Shall the Constitution of Georgia be amended so as to authorize the General Assembly to provide by general law for a state-wide homestead exemption that serves to limit increases in the assessed value of homesteads, but which any county, consolidated government, municipality, or local school system may opt out of upon the completion of certain proce-duree?" dures?'

Summary This proposal amends Article VII, Section II, Paragraph II of the Georgia Constitution to add a new subparagraph (a.1) to authorize the General Assembly to provide by general law for a state-wide uniform homestead exemption. The law may limit this exemption to different political subdivisions that do not already have existing homestead exemptions, and may pro-vide for political subdivisions to opt out, or for future political subdivisions to opt in.
