Union County Sheriff's Capt. Chad Deyton.

The more than 200 grams of methamphetamine and \$16,000 in cash were seized from Christie Goode and Matthew Vaughn, Sgt. Miller said.

Sixteen persons were identified as the distributors of methamphetamine and or

heroin, Sgt. Miller said.

Basically, we put everything together, secured our search warrants, identified everyone that we knew was distributing the drugs, and then we utilized every law enforcement officer in the county to pull off all these arrests," Sgt. Miller said. "We used our sting operation, and everybody that we knew to be involved, well, they got paid a visit.' Where the drugs

came from remains under

investigation, Capt. Deyton "It wasn't generated here in Union County, we know that

much," he said. Goode, 40, and Vaughn,

29, both move-ins to the Union County community, were the main traffickers of the drugs, Sgt. Miller said. Vaughn was charged

with felony trafficking methamphetamine, felony possession of marijuana, three counts felony distribution of controlled substance methamphetamine, and violation of RICO Act, Union County Jail records show.

Christie Goode has been charged with three counts felony distribution of a controlled substance methamphetamine, violation of RICO Act, and felony parole violation, Union County Jail records show.

"They were bringing it in here," Sgt. Miller said, in reference to Christie Goode and Vaughn.

And like a pyramid scheme, they handed the drugs off to a network of local dealers to sell within the community, Sgt. Miller said. It only made sense to

take down the entire network of distribution with a sting operation.

"That's the only way you can cut the head off the snake," Sgt. Miller said.

"Goode and Vaughn were the main ones bringing it into our county," Sgt. Miller said. "They handed it down and the 14 other folks were selling it in the community."

'There's no telling how many man hours we worked to bring this case to fruition," Capt. Deyton said.
